Adejoke Adebola Adeniyi-Jackson is a dedicated Chief Information/Protocol Officer and serves as the Coordinator of the Vice Chancellor's Office at Kwara State University. Her educational journey began at Chapel Nursery and Primary, Ilorin, and she later pursued her secondary education at the Federal Government Girls' College, New Bussa. In 2000, she earned her Bachelor's degree in Geography from the University of Ilorin. She is currently pursuing her Master's in Public Administration (MPA) at the Kwara State University. Following her graduation, Adejoke embarked on her career journey as an administrative staff during her National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) year at the Bauchi State House of Assembly. Subsequently, she entered the world of journalism as a cub reporter at Mandate Publications, the publisher of the National Pilot Newspaper. Her dedication and hard work led to her rise through the ranks, eventually holding the position of Acting Editor at the newspaper, a position she held until her voluntary resignation in 2020. Adejoke joined Kwara State University as a staff of the University Relations Unit. Isiaka Layiwola, Babatunde is a Principal Information Officer, and the current Personal Assistant (PA) to the Acting Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Shaykh-Luqman Jimoh, since November 2020, as he was to Professor Jimoh's predecessor in office, late Professor Muhammed Mustapha Akanbi SAN, from April 2020 to November 2022.

Isiaka has a Diploma in Mass Communication from College of Arabic and Islamic Legal Studies (CAILS), then an affiliate of Bayero University, Kano (BUK) in 2002. He holds a Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Sociology from University of Ilorin in 2010 and Master of Science (M.Sc.) also in Sociology from the same University of Ilorin in 2015.

He is a seasoned and developmental journalist, content writer, sociologist, criminologist and societal engineer. He has been practicing journalism for over two decades. He has three National academic publications in peer review journals to his credit.

Isiaka began his journalism career in 2002 as a reporter at the defunct People's Advocate Newspaper, a newspaper founded by the Late General Abdulkareem Adisa of blessed memory.

In January 4th 2004, he proceeded to the Kwara State Government owned newspaper, The Herald Newspapers, as a reporter. In the Herald, he was assigned to cover various beats which include the state House of Assembly, the office of the Deputy Governor, office of the Executive Governor, as well as general beats.

While performing his professional duty, Isiaka interviewed three different Nigerian Presidents, several Governors and a host of eminent personalities within and outside Nigeria.

Isiaka rose through the ranks to become senior reporter in the Herald Newspapers.

In March 2014, he joined the services of the University of Ilorin and was seconded to the Directorate of Corporate Affairs where he was writing for the University Bulletin and reporting for the institution's Radio Station (Unilorin 89.3 FM). In 2019, he became the Head of News and Current Affairs Unit of the radio, the position he held until 2020 when he joined the services of Kwara state University (KWASU).

He also served in the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) (From Oct. 2010 till Nov. 2011) as a Class Teacher at Government Day Secondary School, Potiskum, Yobe State, Nigeria

He was a Senior Prefect at Community Secondary School, Ogbondoroko, 1997/1998 session.
